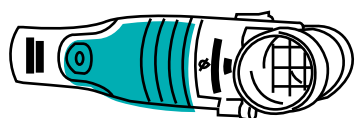
Human Physiology

Go Direct Spirometer

Measure ventilation of the human lungs, respiratory flow rate, tidal volume, and vital capacity.



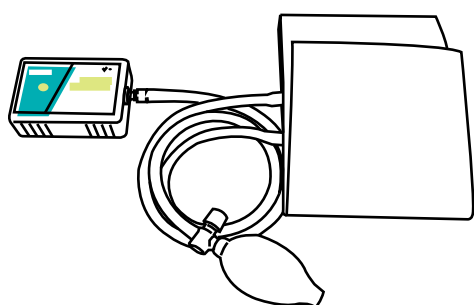
Go Direct Oxygen Gas

Measure blood pressure non-invasively using the oscillometric method.

Record electrical signals produced during heart or muscle contractions.



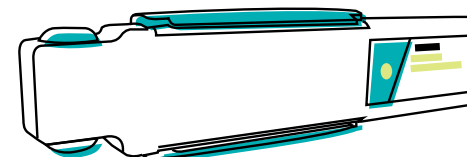
Go Direct Respiration Belt

Measure human breathing patterns.



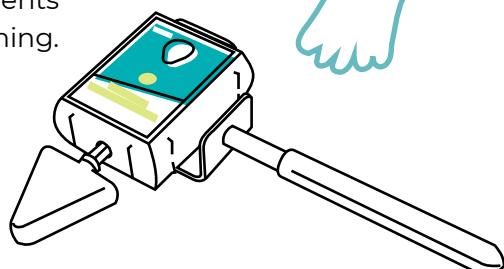
Go Direct Hand Dynamometer

Measure grip and pinch strength, and, when paired with Go Direct EKG, students can perform muscle fatigue studies.



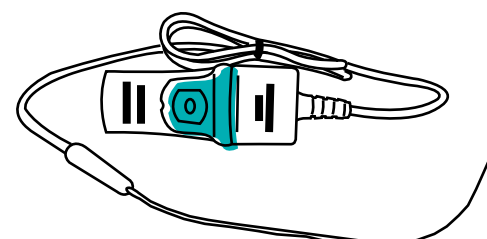
Go Direct Force and Acceleration with Reflex Hammer Accessory Kit
